

In an emergency when a child may be at immediate risk of harm and you are unable to contact the welfare officer or the ASA Child Safeguarding Team, you should:

• Ensure the child is safeguarded at all times.

• Without delay, refer the concern directly to Children's Services, the MASH team or the Police Child Protection Investigation Team, and inform the <u>BSC Welfare Officer – Louise Barratt on 07971</u> 103571 at the earliest opportunity of the concern and any action taken.

• The Family Front Door, Initial Contact and Referral Team is the central point for all referrals for children and young people aged 0 to 18 years and living in Worcestershire where there is safeguarding, or child protection concerns for them.

• This team receives referrals from professionals, members of the community, family members, children and young people directly. If you have concerns that a child is suffering ANY form of neglect, abuse or cruelty, please contact the Family Front Door directly telephone <u>01905 822666</u>.

• If none of these services or agencies are available, If you have a child protection concern outside of normal office hours please contact our out of hours emergency duty team (EDT) telephone <u>01905</u> 768020 or the police using 999 or 101 as appropriate without delay.

• Contact the parents of the child but only if they are not implicated in the concern.
